- c) Qualifications of board members (required by IRS) will be listed as "Philatelist" for all, and "Nonprofit Management" for Jeff.
- d) Jeff to obtain and forward previous 5 years of revenues/expenses reports and balance sheets from Barbara to Mark.
- e) Need resolution to empower Treasurer to track and monitor and report on donation recipients.

- a) Mark visited the BCEC and Waterfront area with Carol Bommarito (Art Director) and Dan Piazza of the Smithsonian (Heritage Events) in November.
- b) Reaching out to decorators (largest expense). This will include GES and Heritage.
